We are learning how to write an interesting and detailed character description about a pirate.

#### What does a character description need to include?

- ❖ Interesting expanded noun phrases to describe the physical details and appearance of the character and what he/she is wearing. This will help the reader build up a picture of your character.

E.g. The pirate had long, tangled hair. He/she wore scruffy, torn trousers and a black, shiny eyepatch;

- ❖ How the character is feeling.

E.g. Jack/Martha was a jolly, smiley boy/girl.

- ❖ Where the character lives.

E.g. The pirate lived aboard an enormous, wooden ship in the middle of the bright blue ocean;

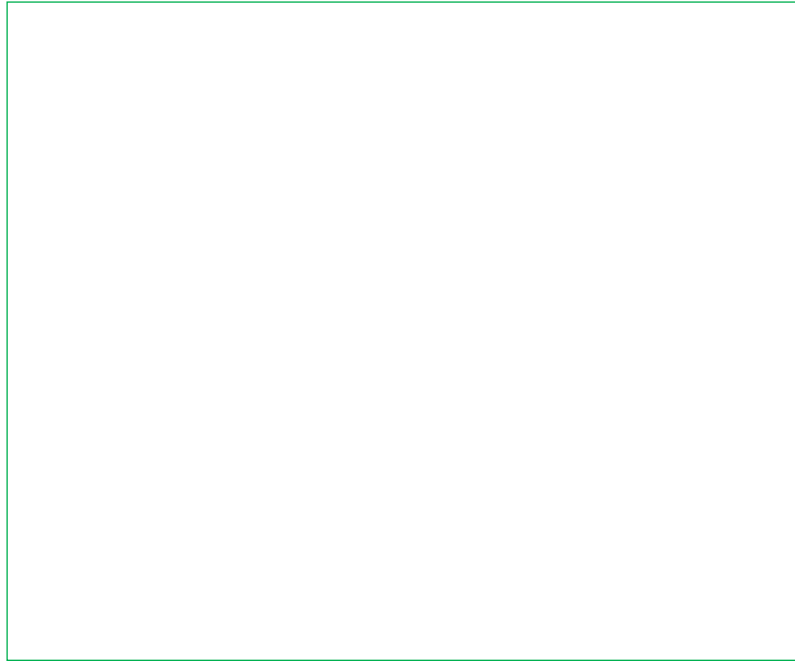
- ❖ What they like/dislike.

E.g. Jack/Martha loved to count his/her gold first thing **every** morning;

- ❖ What they do.

E.g. The old pirate spent every day sailing on his/her ship across the beautiful, blue ocean.
